The APPA the Awards and Recognition Committee has merged with the Professional Affairs Committee. The region A&R representatives still review and recommend approval of individual awards but now also assists the region PAC representatives with scoring some of the institutional awards if the volume of institution award applications warrants the assistance.

The team leads for the Award for Facilities Excellence site visits are region PAC representatives. Region A&R representatives participate on the AFE site visits to help complete the teams and to provide learning/development opportunity. I am serving as the team lead for one of the two scheduled AFE site visits. Both AFE site visits are scheduled for March 26-28.

The PAC continues to meet monthly for a one hour telecon to conduct committee business.

The PAC and A&R committees met at University of Arizona on January 28, 2017 to review and discuss team members' individual scoring, variations, make adjustments, and to finalize scoring and recommendations. The region A&R Committee representatives scored the Effective & Innovative Awards this year to assist the PAC representatives. The committee completed our work of finalizing the scoring and made the recommendations for the institution awards.

Award for Facilities Excellence – 4 nominations, 2 selected for site visits

Effective and Innovative Award – 14 nominations, 5 awarded (maximum allowed)

Sustainability Award – 17 nominations, 5 awarded

The institution award presentations will be at the July 22 awards banquet at the APPA Annual Conference in San Francisco.

2018 award nominations and applications are due Nov 30, 2017.
